I/WE shall at all times take all reasonable precautions to prevent accidents and illness during the indicated training periods by providing adequate coaching or parental supervision of the Swimmer(s) during the indicated training periods and shall as soon as possible after the occurrence of any injury, loss or damage agree to notify the BSF of the date, place and circumstances of such an occurrence. I/WE understand that the BSF Council may cancel the Club's or an Unattached Swimmer's permission to train at the National Swim Complex at any time if the Council determines that the Club or the Swimmer is abusing the privilege, is not adequately supervised by a parent, is damaging the facilities, is being trained by an unregistered coach/instructor, or as a result of withdrawal of permission to train at the Swim Complex by the Ministry for Sports.
